# John H. Foster

**M**r. Foster is a 37-year veteran of private equity investing and a successful entrepreneur/executive.

He founded Foster Management Company in 1972, which managed seven private equity funds. Mr. Foster was founder and CEO of most of Foster Management's portfolio companies including Foster Medical Corporation and NovaCare, Inc.

He is Healthpoint Capital's specialist on China: Trustee of the Asia Fund, Asian Cultural Council and a Founder/Advisory Board Member of the Asia Society Policy Institute.

He currently serves on the boards of NCADD, Alphatec Spine, Inc., MicroDental, Inc. and SinoRehab.

He was formerly a Board Member of Avon, Inc. and Corning Incorporated, a Trustee of the Asia Society, the Hospital for Special Surgery in New York, the Burke Rehabilitation Hospital, and the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, on the Dean's Council at the Harvard School of Public Health, and an Overseer of the Amos Tuck School of Business Administration.

Mr. Foster received a B.A. from Williams College and M.B.A from Dartmouth College.

**M**ichael A. Clinton was named president, marketing and publishing director of Hearst Magazines in June 2010. He is also a member of the Board of Directors of Hearst Corporation.

His responsibilities include overseeing the publishing side of 21 Hearst titles, including *Cosmopolitan*, *ELLE*, *Esquire*, *Harper's BAZAAR*, *O*, *The Oprah Magazine* and *Town&Country*.

In addition, Clinton oversees all print and digital, corporate sales and marketing, and consumer marketing initiatives for Hearst Magazines.

Clinton joined Hearst in October 1997 as senior vice president, chief marketing officer, and added group publisher responsibility for five titles, including *Esquire* and *House Beautiful*, in 1998.

Prior to his time at Hearst, Clinton spent 12 years at *Conde Nast*, as executive vice president, senior vice president and before that, publisher of *GQ*.

Clinton is the founder and president of the non-profit organization, *Circle of Generosity*. He has served as chairman of the board of the *Volunteers of America*, as well as on the boards of *The Starlight Children's Foundation* and *Lifetime Television Network*. He also serves as a trustee for the *International Center of Photography*.

Clinton is an avid traveler and photographer and is the author of eight books, *Wanderlust: 100 Countries*, *A Personal Journey*, a collection of essays and photographs from all seven continents; *Global Snaps*; *Global Faces*; *American Portraits from 100 Countries*; *Global Remains*; *The Globetrotter Diaries*, and *CLOSER* and *Hamptons*.

Clinton graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's in economics and political science from the *University of Pittsburgh*, and earned his M.B.A. from *Pace University's Lubin Graduate School of Business*. He also holds an honorary doctorate from *Pace University*.


